**Regular Town Board Meeting**  
**October 21, 2025**

The regular meeting was held at the Town Hall. Chairman Traynor called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

Clerk Cheryl True read the September meeting minutes. Motion made by Marc Ince to approve the minutes. Motion seconded by Mike Kelby. All in favor. Motion carried.
